Officers Meeting

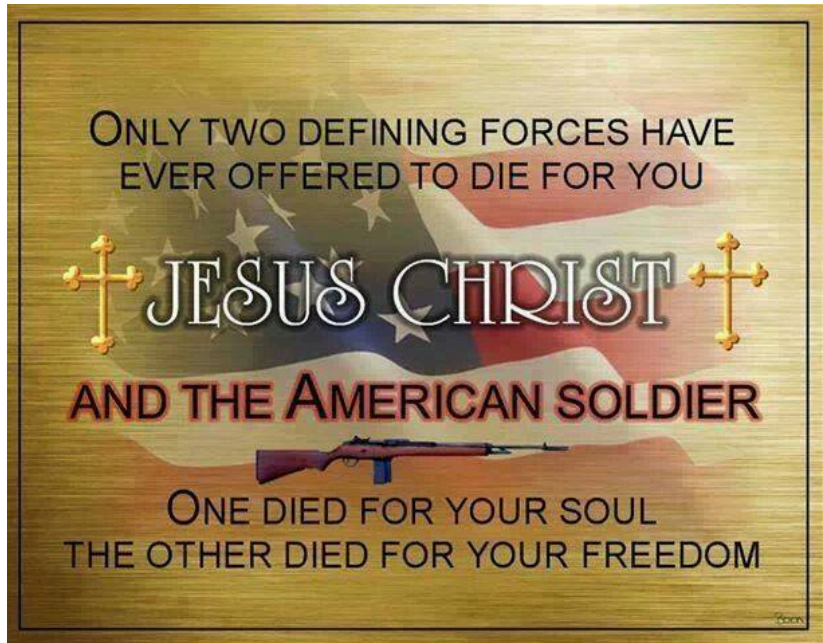
July meeting is moved from July 4th to **July 6th** (wonder why?) with location at the IHOP on Durand Avenue.
