



## Divine Mercy Holy Hour

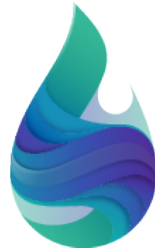

## Team Wisconsin

The Knights of Columbus' longstanding partnership with Special Olympics Wisconsin (SOWI) has made a significant impact on the lives of more than 10,000 children and adults with intellectual disabilities throughout the state. SOWI values the unwavering commitment and genuine enthusiasm demonstrated by the Knights of Columbus' leadership and members alike. Since 2010, the Knights of Columbus has committed \$100K to support SOWI's Team Wisconsin in their quest to compete in the Special Olympics USA Games. 2018 marks our third commitment to supporting the Special Olympics USA Games.

The 2018 Special Olympics USA Games will be held in Seattle, WA, July 1-6. Team Wisconsin consists of 54 inspiring competitors, each training for gold medals in Athletics (Track & Field), Basketball, Bocce, Bowling, Swimming, and Soccer. 2018 also marks the 50th Anniversary of Special Olympics. This incredible milestone not only celebrates the talents and achievements of individuals with intellectual disabilities (ID) but also positions the movement for the next 50 years: to end discrimination against people with ID.
